

Please comply with the following Campsite Rules.

- **All Camps and Nights Away experience or events must be run in accordance with the Policy, Organisation and Rules of the Scout or Guide Association (as appropriate).**
- Entrance to the site is from a private gateway from Hocombe Road opposite the junction with Kingsway. This access also serves the Private estate and must be kept closed at all times.
- All vehicles must be parked in the car park area along the site entrance road. Vehicles may only be brought onto the site itself for unloading / loading of equipment.
- The site is within the private Cranbury Park Estate. *The Lake, Woodland and fields around the site are **out of bounds** to all site users.* Use may be made of the public footpath along the northern side of the site.
- NO FIRE is to be lit on the ground, except within the main campfire area.
- No turfing, pits or fire holes to be dug, consequently only above ground wet pits may be used. Altar fires may be used for cooking.
- No animals (inc. pets), or birds of prey of any description are allowed on the site.
- No Shooting allowed – Please discuss possible local options for Archery / Air Rifles with booking clerk if required.
- No Caravans or camper vans are allowed on site.
- Please ensure that when you leave the site, it is left as you would expect to have found it on arrival.
- The toilets drain into a septic tank and therefore nothing other than normal toilet waste or toilet tissue is flushed away.
- The Buildings and facilities must be kept and left clean and tidy.
- **We have no facilities to dispose of rubbish. Please remove your own from the site when you leave.**
- The site will be inspected before your departure and any damage must be paid for.
